



### **Become a Counselor-in-Training!**

Manchester Summer Scholar's new Counselor-in-Training (CIT) program enables students who have participated in the program before and who are no longer eligible to take courses at Manchester Summer Scholars to still participate in the excitement and master new skills!

Throughout the week, Counselors in Training will master new leadership skills and learn in a hands-on and behind-the-scenes manner as they discover the logistics of program and event management. Moreover, the CIT program affords students the opportunity to continue to participate in various classes by assisting the instructors during certain hours of the day.

All Counselors in Training will work closely with the Camp Director, and will have the opportunity to develop and lead activities during recess for campers, assist in event management at Camp Registration, the Drama & Theater production, the Film Premiere and more.

### **Benefits of Becoming a CIT**

Students in the CIT program will not only master new skills in leadership, problem solving and event management through a curriculum that will include lessons, exercises and hands-on activities, but they also will gain real world work experience that may be used to supplement future resumes.
